- How can you draw hope from the fact that Christ could return at any time and reunite you with God forever?

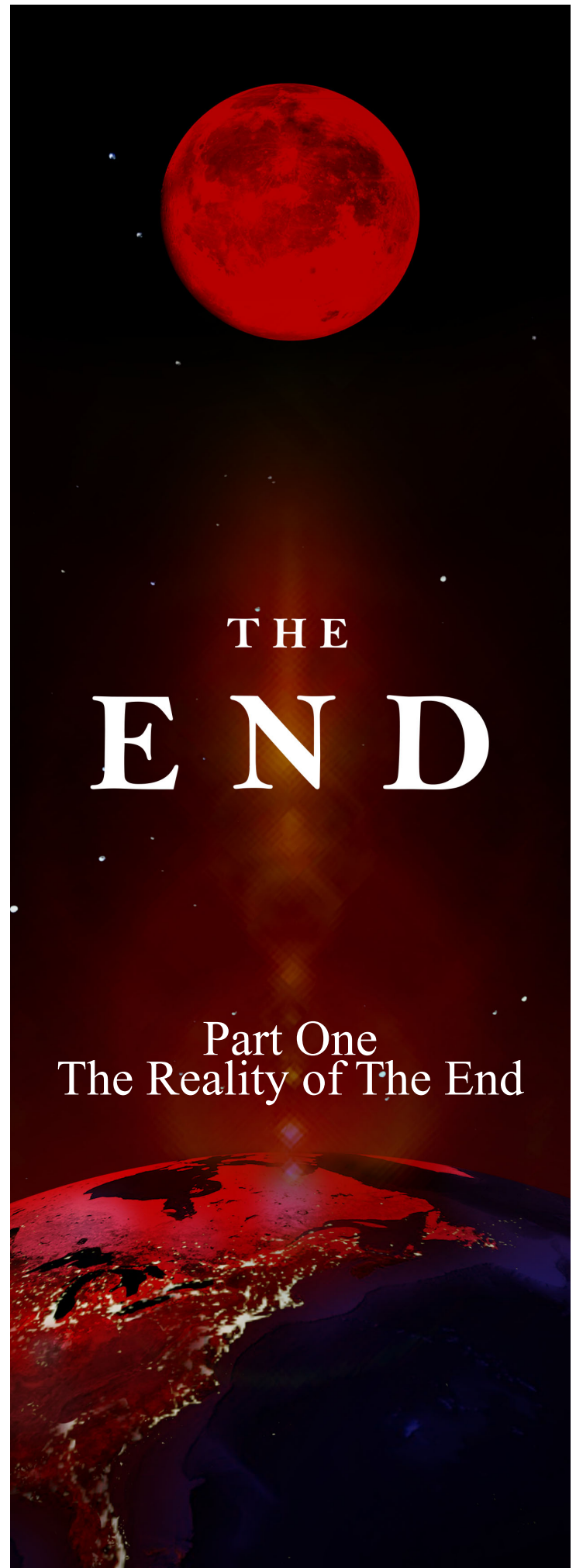
Next Steps
