Why Christians Don't Evangelize Don't Know How— Many have not learned the basics of sharing their faith.










What is Evangelism? ευανγελιον—"gospel"—to describe what is said (Mark 1:14–15) ευανγελιστεσ—"evangelist"—to describe the person who is telling the gospel (Acts 21:8; Eph. 4:11) ευανγελιζο— "to proclaim the gospel"—to describe the activity of telling the gospel (Rom. 10:15).

What is Evangelism? Our attempt to describe what happens when someone, the euangelistes, tells the euangelion, which is the 'good news' about Jesus Christ. You cannot separate the good message from the

good messenger.





Jesus Calls the Twelve

"And He went up on the mountain and summoned those whom He Himself wanted, and they came to Him. And He appointed twelve, so that they would be with Him and that He could send them out to preach, and to have authority to cast out the demons." Mark 3:13-15



Jesus Sends the Twelve

"And He summoned the twelve and began to send them out in pairs, and gave them authority over the unclean spirits. " Mark 6:7





"Statistics in among Seventh-day Adventist churches tell us that 80% of those brought into the church and remain loyal are brought by a friend. When someone comes to know Christ and joins the church by a means other than a friend, that person often times stops attending after a while.
