



How to use Talk it Over:

Pastor Tim's Main Idea:

Some struggle with a belief that the church is the buildings or programs but rather it is the people of God, called out of the world into His Kingdom.

Key Questions:

- Why do you come to church? What does it mean to you? What's the point for you?
- Do you find that your view of the church is more consumer-driven or mission-driven. Why do you feel that way?
- How does our understanding of the church's purpose effect how we do church?
