



How to use Talk it Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your family / friends turn what God is saying to you into action steps.

Pastor Tim's Main Idea:

In order to become sons and daughters of God, we must fully die to self by surrendering to Christ and making Him Lord over every area of our lives.

Key Questions:

- What's one idea from the message that really stood out to you? Why did this idea grab your attention?
- According to Romans 12:1-2, what does it mean to be a living sacrifice?
- Why is it easy to give Christ control over some areas in our lives over others? What are some of the easier and harder areas?
- What makes some areas more difficult to surrender?

Next Steps

- What's one thing you will do this week as a result of something you learned from this message?
- Take time to think of all the different areas of your life and ask whether you have surrendered it to Jesus Christ. If you have not, consider doing so.
- Take time to praise God for the gift of salvation and the joy of being His son or daughter.
