Key Questions:

- What does biblical transformation look like- in real terms? How would you describe it?
- According to Galatians 5, how is the church suppose to be different from the world?
- If transformation comes from the heart, how does it manifest itself externally?

Next Steps

- What's one thing you will do this week as a result of something you learned from this message?
- Reflect on your life and how Jesus has been transforming you into his image. Identify specific exams or experiences.
- Take some time together with people that truly know you and ask how they see the character of Jesus in your life.
